**RAILWAY NOTES**  
The rolling stock of the Utah & Northern consists of sixteen locomotives, ten passenger coaches, seven baggage, mail and express cars, one car, six cabooses, two box cars, twelve stock cars, eighty one flat cars, making a total of 287 cars for this road of 273 miles. The Utah and Northern trade has become so extensive that it is necessary for the road to do the business. The coming season will greatly increase the business, because of the great immigration to the Snake and Salmon river countries. Goods are arriving even now, and being placed in storage here, to await the opening of spring for transit to the mining districts approached by this road.

**The Public Lands Bill.**  
Fuller details are given of Powell's minority report on Public Lands, published heretofore. Powell suggests several important amendments affecting the disposal of pasturage, and mineral lands. First of these is as follows: In lands patented under the provisions of this chapter all subterranean mining property and rights for mining purposes are hereby reserved from surface property and rights for pasturage purposes and whenever surface property and rights for pasturage purposes to any tract of land have passed from the Government under the provisions of this Act, subterranean property and rights for mining purposes therein may be acquired under the provision of the 13th Chapter of this Act, etc.

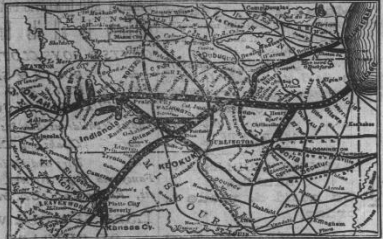

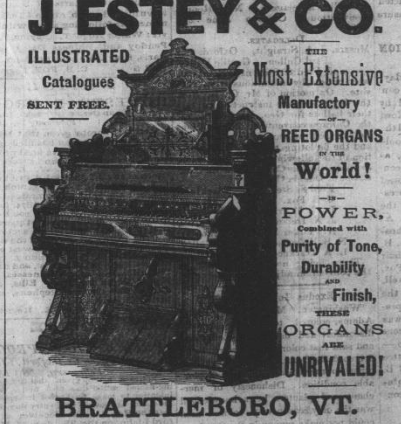
