The President.

Maine Talks.

AUGUSTA, Sept. 20.—Blaine says: The only opportunity for fraud in the election returns under our laws is in the French plantations of Arisook, where the voters are eight, the returns, expressed in language with which they are entirely unacquainted. 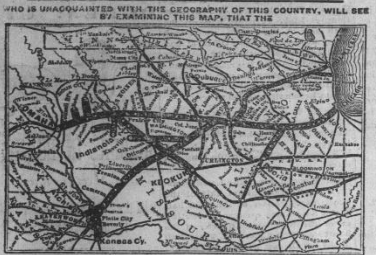
