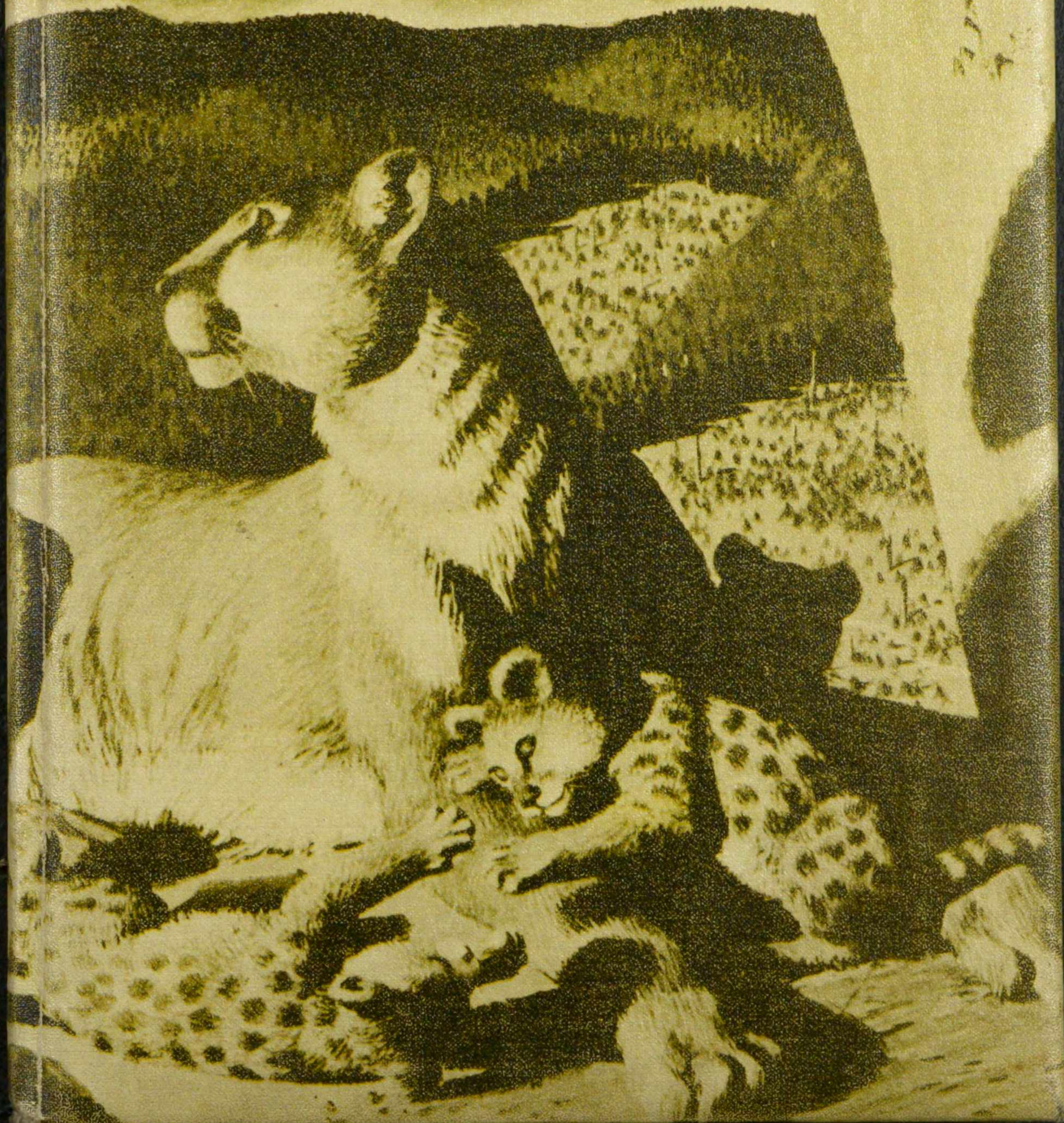

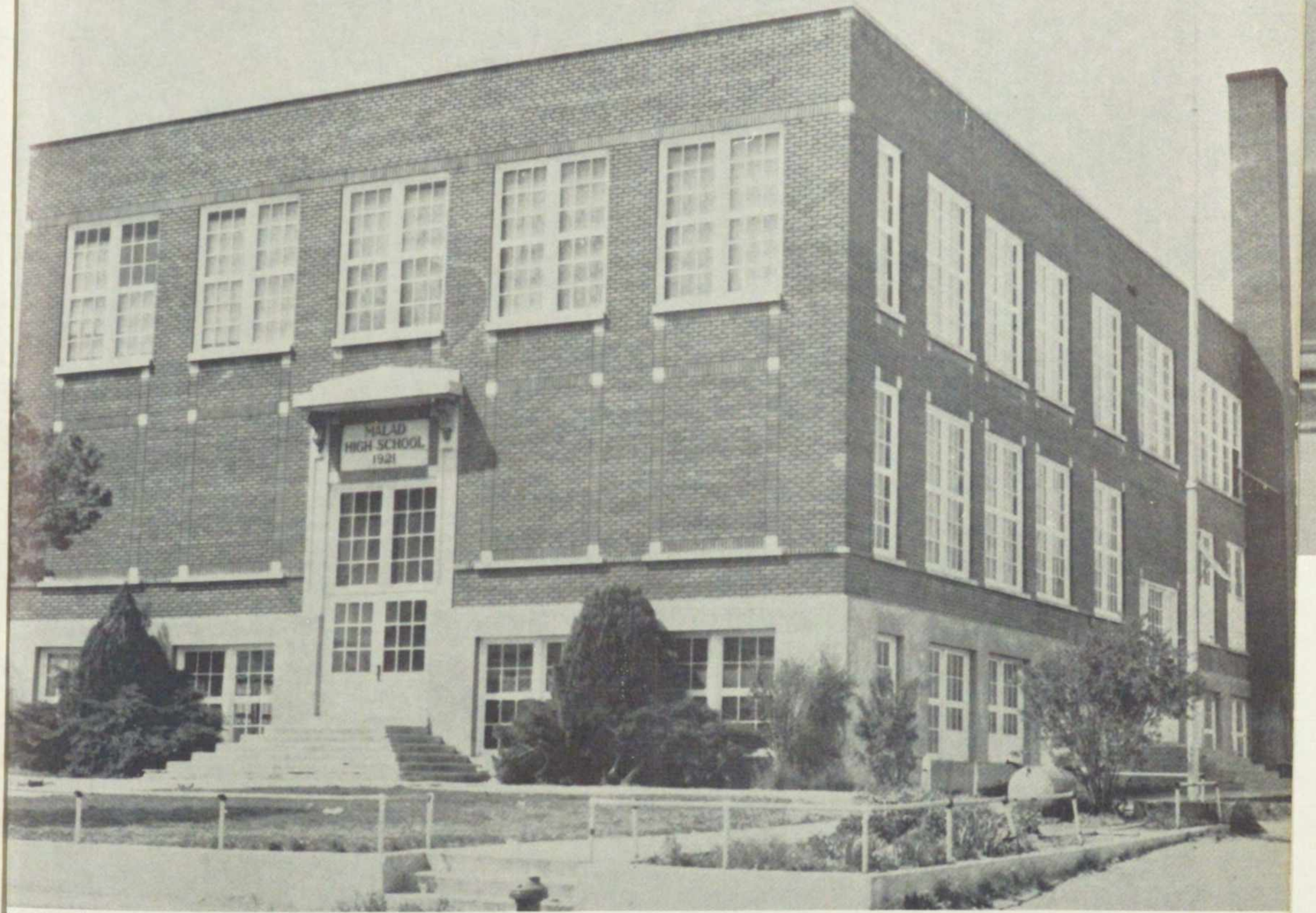

1955 is not so much the conclusion of one phase of your life as it is the beginning of a great and new experience--the experience of entering into the fuller and richer life that comes with the adult years.

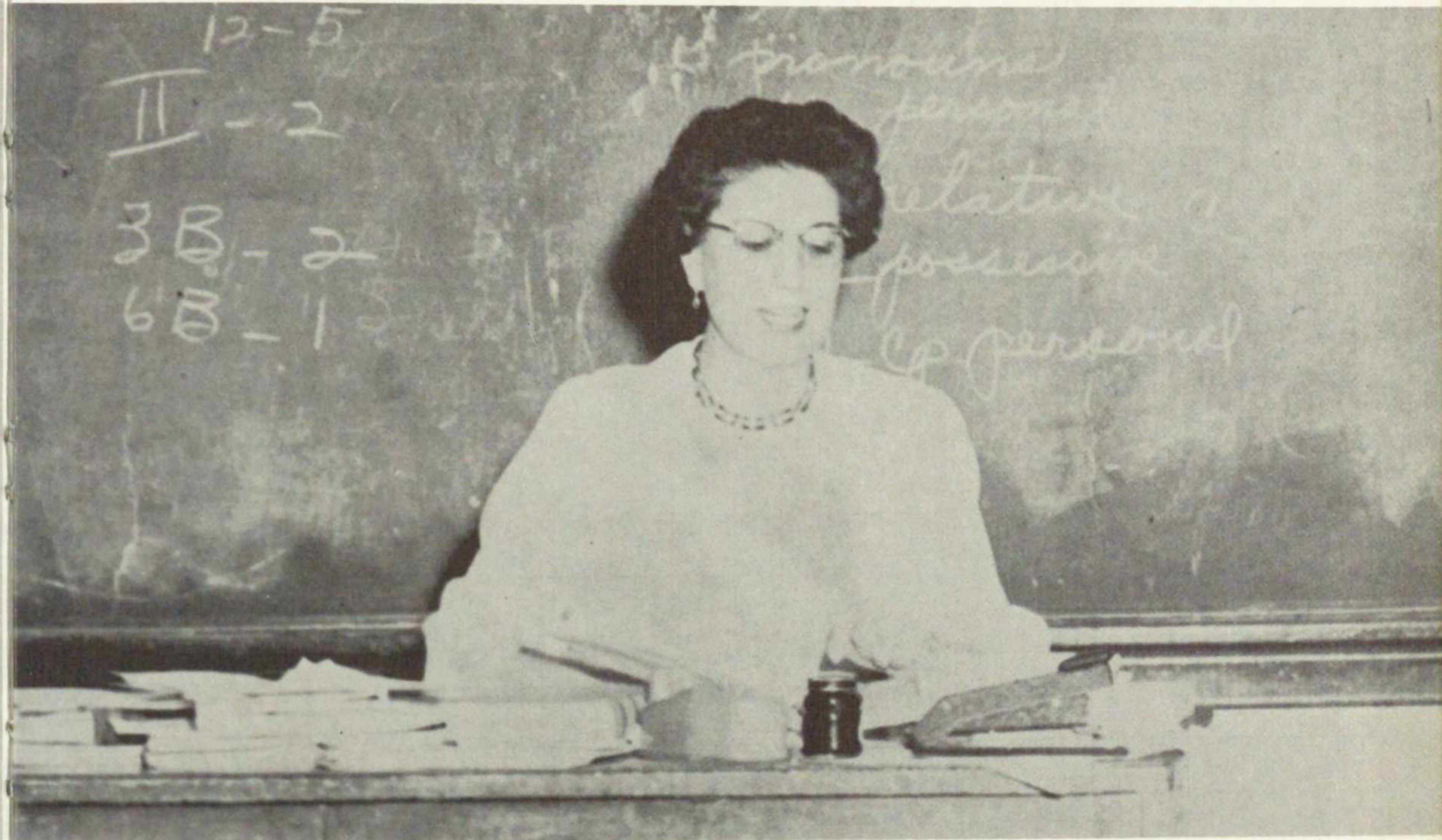
May these years to follow be filled with the truly important things--family love, honest work, wholesome fun, church and prayer, and the privilege of serving your country which so well has served you.
